WHAT GOES IN

Paper Products

- Newspapers and Flyers
- Magazines and catalogues
- Glossy paper and junk mail
- Computer paper, writing paper, bond paper
- Phonebooks, envelopes, books
- Toilet paper & paper towels rolls
- Egg Cartons, drink/coffee trays
- Paper Bags

Boxes

- Box packaging
- Shoe boxes and gift boxes
- Corrugated cardboard boxes (flattened or bagged)

Aluminum Containers

- Pop and beer cans
- Baking trays, pie plates, etc

Tin Cans

- Soup cans, coffee cans, beans, tuna, cat food, etc

Plastic Containers

- Water, pop and liquor bottles
- condiments, like barbeque sauce, ketchup, mustard, honey, etc
- Household cleans, like dish and laundry detergent, bleach, Windex, windshield wash, etc
- Toiletries, like shampoo, mouthwash, hand soap, body wash

WHAT STAYS OUT

Paper (not recyclable)

- Bubble envelopes
- Candy wrappers
- Toilet paper and tissue
- Paper towels
- Take-out paper bags
- Wax paper
- Napkins
- Pet food bags
- Take out drink containers
- Coffee cups
- Gift wrapping paper
- Diapers

Containers (not recyclable)

- Glass bottles
- Styrofoam
- Aerosol cans
- Plastic bags
- Plastic wrap, saran wrap
- Propane tanks
- CD cases
- Full or unopened food containers
- Paint cans
- Toys (plastic, wood, metal)
- Diapers
- Kitty Litter

Please note that all plastic bags such as supermarket bags, household garbage bags, also glass bottles (wine, liquor, beets, etc) are NOT part of the recycling program.

If any items that are identified as NOT acceptable, shall be rejected and the full bag of recyclables will be considered garbage.
